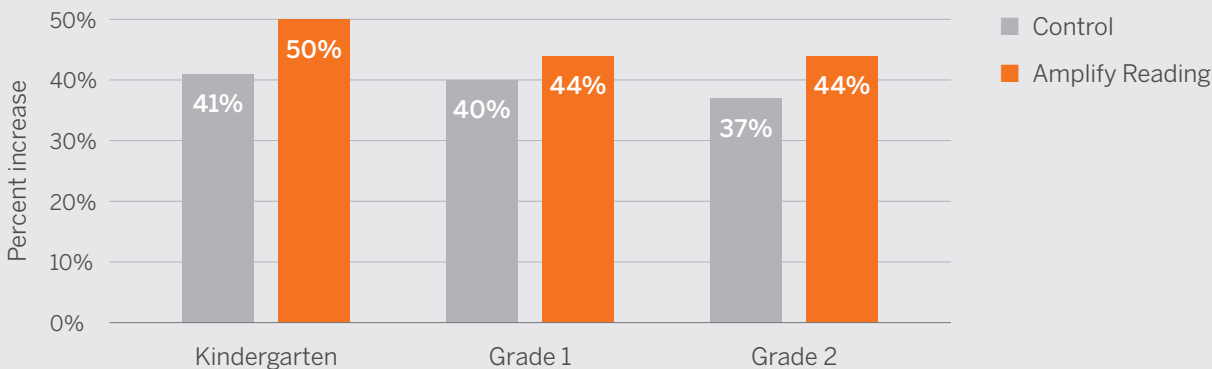
# Instruction with real impact

Amplify Reading recently completed a semester-long study with a large urban district in California. The study included over 16,000 students using Amplify Reading in the spring semester, as well as a comparison group of over 50,000 students from the district, matched on key demographic and school data. The results? Amplify Reading drives student growth in as little as one semester.

### Amplify Reading students made better than expected growth

Compared with those who did not use the program, more Amplify Reading students made “above typical” progress from the beginning to the end of the year, measured with DIBELS Next Pathways of Progress. For example, in kindergarten, **50%** of students enrolled in Amplify Reading made “above typical” progress, whereas only **41%** of the students in the comparison group made “above typical” progress.

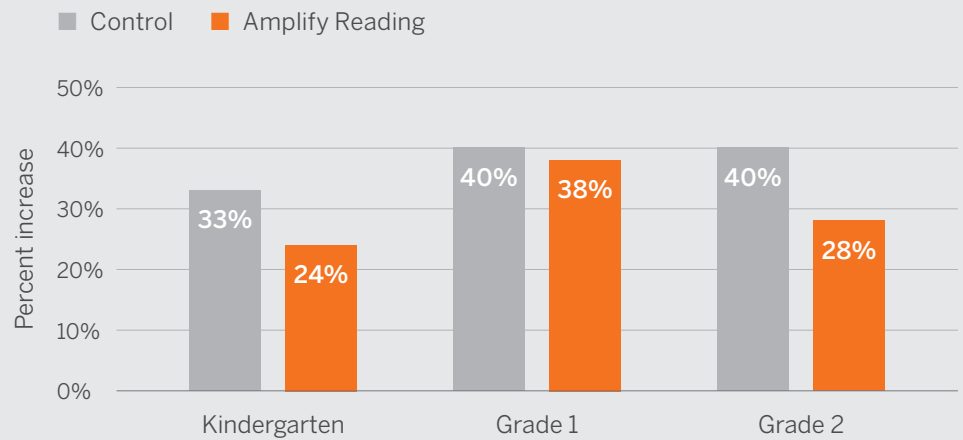
Percentage of students making above typical progress



## Amplify Reading improves student performance, reducing the percentage of students at risk

Amplify Reading had a significant effect on students' end-of-year performance on the DIBELS Next assessment. For example, **9%** fewer Amplify Reading students were categorized as "at risk" in kindergarten and **12%** fewer in grade 2.

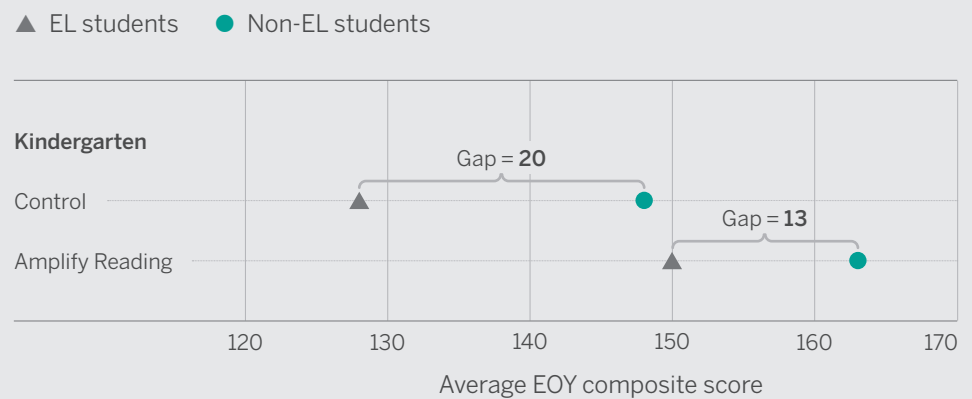
### Percentage of students who finished the year at risk for reading difficulty



## Amplify Reading helps English learners close the achievement gap

The performance gap between English learners and non-English learners was smaller for students who used Amplify Reading. For example, kindergarten English learners not using Amplify Reading had a performance gap of **20 DIBELS composite score points** behind their non-English learner peers. For those using Amplify Reading, this gap was only **13 points**.
